

Celtic FC appeals process

Reason for the process

This appeals process has been put in place to ensure that any decisions made by the Club Committee are made in a fair and transparent manner and that should any party feel that a decision has been made unfairly there is a clear and simple process to appeal the decision.

How

Should The Club make a decision that affects an individual that individual has the right to appeal the decision to the Club Committee within 30 days of the original decision being made. If the individual notifies the Club Committee of their desire to submit an appeal after the 30 day period there is no obligation of the Club Committee to accept the appeal or not.

Any appeal to a decision must be made by the individual in writing or by email to the Club Committee stating their reasons why they would like to appeal the decision. All information and evidence must be submitted at the time of the appeal and no further information can be submitted once the original appeal has been submitted.

The appeal must be submitted by the individual affected and not by any third party or secondary individual within The Club as determined by the Club Committee.

Upon receipt of the appeal, it will be recorded and the Club Committee will meet to hear the appeal and decide upon the final decision. Once the Club Committee has made a decision on the appeal, this decision will be the final decision and will not be able to be appealed further. The Club Committee will communicate the final decision to the appellant with the explanation for the decision.

In the event that the Club Committee are unable to make a majority decision on the appeal the Club Chairman will have the casting vote on the appeal to decide upon the outcome.
